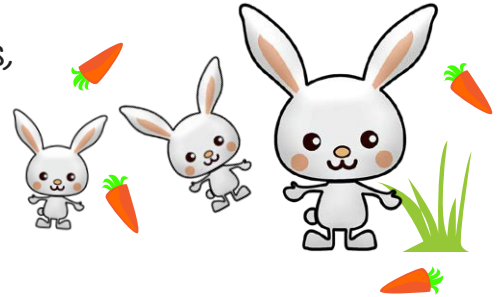

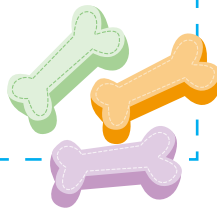
I'd like a pet.

and some that like to fly!



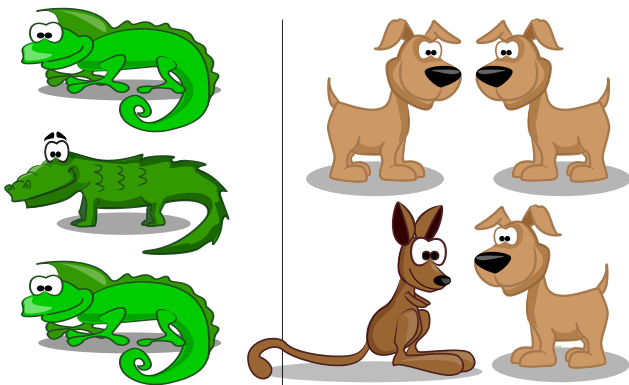

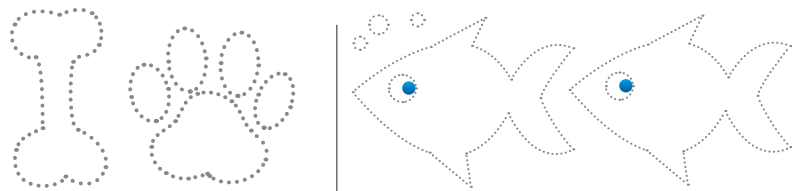

## Pet Activity Suggestions! fun Pet projects and games

- # Turn home corner into a vet or pet shop
- # Show and tell using photos of pets at home
- # Introduce an animal into the room. Allow the children to feed and care for it daily
- # Add books to book corner about pets
- # Pet Movements : educator calls out different animals for children to imitate as they move around the room

- # Pet Food Playdough : children roll playdough into small balls to make dog or cat food and put it in a small dog/cat bowl
- # Making animal houses : use boxes to make animal houses
- # Police dog visit
- # Songs for music session could be "old Mother Hubbard" and "how much is that doggie in the window"

- # Make animal masks
- # Pet paw print art
- # Pet flash cards : use animal flash cards and ask children to decide if the animal could be a pet or not
