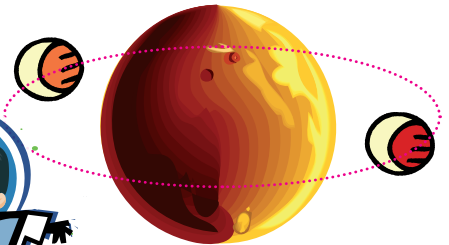
Let's sing!

Into Space we will fly, blasting in our Rocket ships as stars and meteors zoom by!

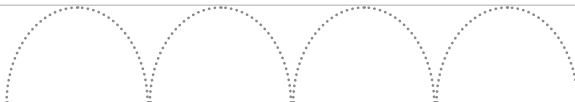
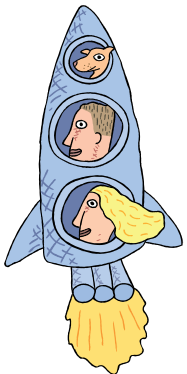
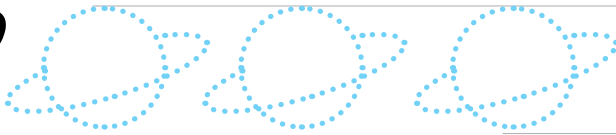
What does the Moon look like?
