Activity Suggestions! Have a super Day!

- # Add capes and dress up items to the dramatic play area
- # Create hero ribbons for the children to give to someone they believe is a hero. Have a discussion about what might make someone a hero. Eg helping someone or a time when they were brave
- # Make a super hero obstacle course
- # Add super hero action figures to the block corner or sandpit
- # Make super hero finger puppets
- # Follow flash (same as follow the leader, however, the leader is dressed in a cap and mask)
