
Let's sing!

There are a lot of different ways to get around, we can travel in the sky, on the sea or along the ground!


How do you like to travel?

Activity Suggestions! On your mark, get set, go!

- # Car painting
- # Add trains, trucks, Planes, cars etc to the block corner
- # Train tracks and trains
- # Trough of mud, trucks, ramps etc
- # Make cardboard tube cars

- # Transport sensory tub
- # Folding and flying paper planes
- # Make and float boats out of egg cartoons
- # Water trough outdoors with transport items

- # Parking Garage - On a large sheet of paper draw a grid with numbered squares.
- # Collect small cars with numbers on them, Have the students "drive" the cars to their matching "parking spot" with the same number.

- # Vehicle Sounds - Have a CD of various transportation sounds. The children listen to the CD and have to tell you which vehicle makes that sound.
